SVCE provides residents and businesses with carbon-free electricity at lower rates and offers innovative clean energy programs.

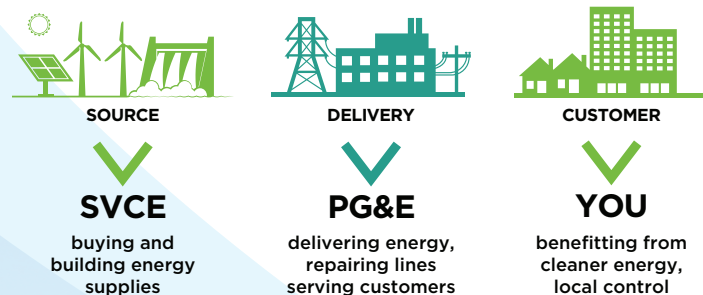

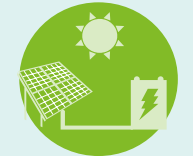
