Subject: Request for action on problem with \$50 bill rebate to be considered by board and staff

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Regarding the \$50 bill reduction program, I am pleased to see that SVCE acknowledges (Peyton Parks email Oct 23, 2025) that the \$50 bill reduction program as carried out is of no use to those clients who spent considerable funds to invest in clean energy solar panels and who conserve energy daily and who can produce more energy than they use. Given the above, SVCE is offering to have the \$50 credit retracted from the reserve account and instead issuing a check for the \$50 and recalculating the NEM escrow in a subsequent statement to those so affected. This is a fair and viable solution and well within the SVCE objectives.

SVCE has the demonstrated means and information to do this for all overproducing customers and I request you begin this process as soon as practicable. I particularly hope that all board members in different geographical areas they represent will take the time and effort to check with those they represent to see if their residents are in favor of receiving a \$50 check where applicable rather than a useless credit.
