Director of Account Services and Community Relations Don Bray introduced the item and presented a PowerPoint presentation on potential SVCE rate options. Staff responded to committee member questions.

CEO Girish Balachandran proposed staff present a rate schedule to the Board in April, effective May, June, and July of 2019, and present a request to the Board in June to give the CEO authority, given certain assumptions, to set rates with particular constraints.

Committee members discussed the various rate options presented by staff.

Vice Chair Miller opened public comment.

James Tuleya, Sunnyvale resident, commented on his support for *Option B: Two rate changes -- 6% discount to PG&E's generation rates May 1st and 1% discount to PG&E's generation rates August 1st, presented by staff. Tuleya commented on his experience with customers and noted a more stable, dampened move in rates is a better approach.*

Vice Chair Miller closed public comment.

The committee was in consensus to request staff outline *Option B: Two rate changes --3% rate increase effective May 1st that restores the 6% discount to PG&E's generation rates and a 1 ½% rate decrease that would reduce the discount to PG&E's generation rates to 1% effective August 1st. Staff clarified they would bring the rate schedules in effect May – July 31, 2019 to the April Board meeting, update the Board at the June Board meeting with any new information on PG&E and PCIA rates, and present the SVCE rate schedules that were implemented, based on direction from the Board, at the August Board meeting. The committee agreed to hold a special meeting in July to discuss rates, if needed.*

Committee members provided feedback on the presentation and offered suggestions on amendments for the Board.

CEO Balachandran summarized the key policy points the committee considered in the recommendation:

Stable, small changes are better than a volatile market;

Fiscally responsible; Enhances flexibility; Manages risk;

Maintains a discount; and

Allows SVCE to remain carbon-free.

Director Smith requested staff present a procedural report on what would happen if things do not go as planned and a special meeting is needed.

CEO Balachandran requested the committee move Item 4) *Built Environment Programs – Background and Interim Update* to the April Executive Committee meeting, and address the additional remaining items in a timely fashion due to scheduling constraints; there were no objections from the committee.

Bruce Karney, resident of Mountain View, commented on the difficulties of getting online lightly connected groups to take action. Karney suggested people with connections to Sacramento should be the number one group to engage with, including current colleagues on council, former colleagues on council, and former SVCE Board of Directors.
