The committee discussed SVCE projected rate options, the proposed discount framework, SVCE reserves, and staff's recommendation to direct the CEO and staff to implement a rate change that results in a \$11-13 MM incremental revenue, currently forecast to result in a 3% discount to current PG&E generation rates effective August 1st subject to delegate authority to adjust the discount based on 'Discount Framework', and the combined effect of actual July 1 PG&E rate and PCIA changes.
