#### **Call to Order**

Chair Miller called the meeting to order at 8:31 a.m.

### Public Comment on Matters Not Listed on the Agenda

Bruce Karney commented customers on Sonoma Clean Power's premium product are receiving renewable energy 24 hours a day, seven days a week due to having geothermal energy in their mix; Karney suggested SVCE may want to offer that kind of product as its premium product.

Karney commented on joining together with other CCAs and cities to fund PG&E's ability to charge a higher gas tax than electricity tax, and would like to make it clear that it is a good idea to increase demand for electricity, suppress demand for gas, and also for the cities that do not have a natural gas or electricity utility user tax, give them a new way to raise revenue that is climate friendly at the same time as being budget friendly.

Chair Miller inquired if PG&E has the system to charge two different taxes; Karney responded that they do not currently have the system and the point of the appeal to CCAs and cities was to pledge funds for that particular upgrade to the system.

Director Gibbons responded to Karney's comment and provided an example of her experience in discussions regarding a UUT tax in her member agency. Director Gibbons suggested the dialogue and education of council and staff needs to be paid attention to.

#### 2) CEO Update (Discussion)

CEO Girish Balachandran provided a verbal Strategic Plan update and responded to Mr. Karney that his gas tax idea is on staff's list of topics to look into. CEO Balachandran provided an update on long-duration storage, and noted eight CCAs are looking into forming an organization that can transact for large resources. CEO Balachandran provided an update on PG&E's bankruptcy and SB350.

CEO Balachandran introduced Don Rhoads, who would be serving as Interim Director of Finance and Administration upon Director of Finance and Administration Don Eckert's departure, who provided brief introductory comments.

Chair Miller opened public comment.

Tony Eulo inquired about CEO Balachandran's comment on PG&E's bankruptcy and SB350 with the possibility that a group, "Golden State Energy", could be put in place if PG&E goes bankrupt again, and questioned if the group would be an adversary to CCAs.

CEO Balachandran responded to Eulo's inquiry.

Chair Miller closed public comment.

Without objection, Chair Miller announced Item 4) *Building Decarbonization Joint Action Plan*, would be heard before Item 3) *SVCE Messaging and eHub Update*.

## 4) Building Decarbonization Joint Action Plan (Discussion)

Director of Decarbonization and Grid Innovation Programs Aimee Bailey presented a PowerPoint presentation and responded to committee member questions.

Director Gibbons requested staff engage a broad range of people including architects, general contractors, specification writers, etc. and mentioned she shared a link with staff on the Boston Society of Architect's program on decarbonization of buildings.

Vice Chair Smith requested the link sent by Director Gibbons be distributed to the board.

# 3) SVCE Messaging and eHub Update (Discussion)

Director of Account Services and Community Relations Don Bray, Communications Manager Pamela Leonard, and Communications Consultant Beth Trenchard presented a PowerPoint presentation on the new SVCE Customer Resource Center, "eHub"; staff responded to committee member questions.

Chair Miller opened public comment.

Bruce Karney commented he liked the visual identity SVCE established, and encouraged the committee think about: 1) success metrics other than click-throughs, 2) if SVCE really wants homeowners installing more solar, and 3) his opinion the site is single family home owner centric and encouraged staff to think about a segmentation where staff identifies whether the person on the site is a homeowner, renter, or landlord, and if they're living in a single family home or multi-family building.

Chair Miller closed public comment.

Director Sinks requested staff look into vehicle-to-grid solutions (V2G); Director of Account Services and Community Relations Bray responded that staff has looked into V2G.

Director of Finance and Administration Don Eckert presented a PowerPoint presentation on the framework and timeline for the SVCE FY20-21 budget, and responded to committee member questions.

Chair Miller opened public comment.

Bruce Karney commented on direct access customers and the power charge indifference adjustment (PCIA) across rate classes.

Chair Miller thanked Director of Finance and Administration Eckert for his work at SVCE.
