# Member Agency Grant History

1. 2020 Community Resilience Grant Program, \$5M
  - Noncompetitive grants for member agencies
  - Scheduled to conclude 12/2025
2. 2022 Decarb Engagement & Demonstration Grant, \$3.6M
  - Competitive grants for member agencies and schools
  - Scheduled to conclude 12/2025 – 12/2026
3. 2024 Round of Grants, \$6.5M
  - Noncompetitive grants for member agencies
  - Competitive grants for member agencies

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## Impact Snapshot

**Investing over \$15M to support energy resilience, building and transportation electrification, and community engagement in our region.**

**SVCE has funded 27 projects:**

- **9** battery storage projects that provide clean backup power
- **6** building electrification retrofits to remove gas appliances
- **6** community engagement projects that educate the public in innovative ways
- **5** off-grid EV chargers that provide clean mobile charging and 4 fleet Ford F-150 Lightnings
- **1** cool pavement pilot that reduces surface temperature



**Community investments are in direct support of SVCE's mission to provide clean, reliable and affordable energy and support innovative decarbonization programs.**
