

FUTUREFIT HOMES PROGRAM

Silicon Valley Clean Energy customers can receive rebates to upgrade from gas to efficient, electric appliances that makes homes and our community cleaner and safer.



What rebates are available?

Rebates are available for single-family homes, mobile or manufactured homes, accessory dwelling units (ADUs), and multi-family homes (4 dwelling units or fewer) swapping out existing equipment, not for completely new building construction.

Core Rebate amounts:

Heat Pump Water Heater (HPWH)	Gas replacement	\$2,000
	Electric resistance replacement	\$500
Heat Pump Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning system (HP HVAC)	Gas furnace replacement	\$2,500
	Electric resistance furnace replacement	\$1,000
Induction Cooktop/Range	Gas cooktop/range replacement	\$500
	Electric resistance cooktop/range replacement	\$100

Prewiring, wiring (cooking, water heating, space heating, and clothes drying circuits) or circuit splitter/pauser devices

\$500 per circuit or device, up to \$2,000 for 4 circuits

Add-on Rebates

To be eligible for the add-on rebates, you must install at least one of the core rebate appliances.

Electrical infrastructure upgrade (e.g. electric panel upgrade)	\$1,000	Prewiring EV charging circuit	\$500
Induction cookware	Up to \$250	All-Electric Bonus for gas meter removal	\$500
